Dental amalgam is created by mixing elemental mercury (43-54%) and an alloy powder (46-57%) composed mainly of silver, tin and copper.

Now, white Composite Fillings can be used to replace old silver fillings and fix areas of new decay. They are strong and durable and, because they are tooth colored, results are aesthetically pleasing. They look like your natural teeth!

Due to advanced technology, all ceramic crowns now make it possible to restore broken or worn teeth with prosthetics that are amazingly lifelike. Crowns are used when teeth are chipped, broken or the cavity is very large. A crown covers the entire tooth surface adding strength and protecting the remaining tooth structure.
